LUXURY TOPS FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

LUXURY TOPS

PREPARATION



1. Remove the cardboard packaging and set aside. Keep intact.




2. Carefully remove the protective wrapping. (On Grand, open the side windows to release.)



3. Open the bulkhead window and retrieve the fitting kit.

OVER RAIL BED LINERS can cause the hardtop to leak due to an uneven surface. Therefore, Auto Styling Truckman highly recommends converting to or replacing with an under rail bed liner.



4. Locate and assemble the roof bars.



5. Remove the roof bar retaining screws, offer up the bars and re-insert the screws.



6. Make sure the wiring harness is secured away from the bed seal.



7. Remove the bolt caps from the clamps and completely unscrew each of them.



8. Thoroughly clean the vehicle's rear window.



9. Wipe down the top surface of the bed rails.





10. Fill the join between the front and side rails with silicone.

13. Before mounting the canopy, check that the rear door is fully shut and the vehicle's tailgate is closed.

14. Remove the hardtop keys from the handle on the inside of the rear door.



11. Check the level of the bulkhead rail and side rails.



12. If there is a difference apply the self adhesive Neoprene strip (supplied in the fitting kit) to the bulkhead rail. Ensure there are no gaps at the ends.



15. Lift the canopy on to the bed of the vehicle.



16. Carefully adjust the position of the canopy so that the seal under the rear door is just in contact with the tailgate.



17. Check that the top and vehicle bed lines up at the front and does not overhang.



18. Centralise the bottom of the rear door to the tailgate.



19. Then centralise the canopy at the front end.



20. Assemble the clamps loosely in position on the side rails.



21. Tighten the clamps to 8Nm (start with the rear ones).

FITTING

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22. Ensure the rear door fully latches when closed firmly (the seal under the door should now be half compressed).



23. Small adjustments can be made by re-positioning the striker plates.



24. Check the position again and repeat steps 13-20 if necessary. Replace the clamp bolt caps.





25. Thoroughly clean the top of the vehicle's tailgate



26. Unroll the protective tape and cut one end square.



27. Peel away a little of the backing paper.

TIP: Apply a fine spray of water to the top of the tailgate before positioning the protective tape. This will allow a little 'adjustment' before the water dries and the adhesive fixes the tape into position.



28. Carefully apply the tape, where the door seal touches, removing any bubbles as you go.




29. Trim the tape square at the other end.

Caution: Auto electrics should only be carried out by a competent person. Vehicle wire colours are listed as a guide and may vary on some models. The function of each wire should be checked before any connections are made.

Ensure the ignition is switched off and the battery disconnected before soldering any wires.

HARDTOP	FUNCTION	VEHICLE	NOTES - Checked on a '15 plate Navara
GREEN	Heated Screen	BLACK	+12V when the heated screen is on.
BLUE	Brake Light	BLUE	+12V when brake pedal is depressed.

ELECTRICS





1. Remove the screws from the O/S/R light cluster.





2. Release the unit-

4. In the O/S/R of the vehicle's bed, mark 85mm down from the top of

the side rail and 85mm forward from the inside of the tailgate. Drill a 20

mm hole through the liner

body into the light recess.

(if fitted) and the vehicle

3. -disconnect it and set aside.



5. Use corrosion inhibiting paint to treat the cut edges.

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6. Feed the harness through the hole and down to the chassis following the vehicle's wiring loom. Fit the grommet.



7. Peel back the sheathing from the vehicle, s loom.



8. Solder the blue wire on the canopy harness to the blue wire in the vehicle loom.



9. Run the canopy harness along the top of the O/S chassis rail to level with the front of the rear wheel arch.



10. Use the large cable ties to secure the harness (do not tighten at this stage).

11. From the rear wheel arch forward, follow the vehicles wiring loom on the outside of the O/S chassis rail.





12. Remove the sill trim from the driver's door.



13. - and the rubber door seal.



15. Drill a 15mm hole, treat with rust inhibitor, allow to dry then fit the supplied grommet.



16. Pass the shorter ' leg' of the wiring harness through the grommet and into the cab.

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14. Lift the carpet. Make a mark on the sloping surface, just to the rear of the white plastic box.



17. Open the cover of the plastic box to expose the wires.

18. Solder the green wire of the canopy harness to the Heated screen feed wire. (Refer to page 4).



21. The harness can be grasped inside the front wheel arch and fed back behind the liner.

22. Follow the existing loom upwards, taking it to the right side of the steering column shaft.



19. Trim the unused wires in this section of the canopy harness back to the sheathing and secure with insulation tape.




20. Continue feeding the other leg of the wiring harness along the chassis rail. Follow the vehicle's loom.

23. Connect the relay section of the harness to the rear section.

24. Use the illustrations below to route wiring in the engine bay.

NOTE: Do not connect to the battery -Ve terminal

V6 DIESEL



25. Attach the -Ve (Black) wire here.





26. RE-fit the rear light and reconnect the battery then go to page 10 'TESTING'

SECTION ELECTRICS





7. Lift the carpet. Make a mark on the sloping surface, just to the rear of the white plastic box.


8. Drill a 15mm hole, treat with rust inhibitor, allow to dry then fit the supplied grommet.




14. The harness can be grasped inside the front wheel arch and fed back behind the liner

16. Use the illustrations below to route wiring in the engine bay.

NOTE: Connect the Black wire to the vehicle's body. Do not connect to the battery -Ve terminal.



V6 DIESEL

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17. Attach the -Ve (Black) wire here.



18. Remove the screws from the O/S/R light cluster.



19. Release the unit--



20. disconnect it and set aside.



22. Use the large cable ties supplied to secure it.



21. Run the section of the harness containing the blue wire, along the top of the O/S chassis rail to the rear of the vehicle.

23. Take the wire into the O/S/R light recess.

24. Peel back the sheathing from the vehicle,s loom.

25. Solder the blue wire on the canopy harness to the blue wire in the vehicle loom. (Refer to page 4)



26. Re-fit the rear light and reconnect the battery. Continue to TESTING below.





1. Switch the interior light to 'Door'. Check it goes out when the rear door is shut.



2. Switch on the vehicle's heated rear screen and check there is +12v across the element on the hardtop door.

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3. Check the operation of the canopy's brake light.

4. Replace all of the trims and cable tie all wires securely away from moving parts or heat sources.

5. Close all doors and bonnet then repeat steps 1-3. This completes the installation of the **TRUCKMAN** Luxury hardtop.

Use a light oil to lubricate the lock and hinges. Regularly check the tightness of the fixing clamps / bolts.*(6Nm Torque)*

CLEANING Use ordinary non-ammonia based car cleaning products and a soft or microfibre cloth.
