

CLASSIC TOP FITTING INSTRUCTIONS



ISUZU D-MAX MK4

DOUBLE AND EXTENDED CABS

PREPARATION

Tools Required 13mm Spanner 13mm Socket PH2 Screwdriver Tape measure Drill Drill Bits (3 & 9mm) Silicon Sealant

1. Gel Coat Top Remove the shrink wrap packaging, retrieving the kit contents before disposal.

1. Painted Top Remove the cardboard packaging and the kit contents carefully from the pallet.



NOTE: The vehicle's third brake light must be disconnected to avoid glare in the rear view mirror.



2. Remove the bolts. washers, fixing plates & nuts from the kit



3. Unscrew the vehicle's third brake light and pull it away from the bodywork.

4. Unclip the connector and disconnect the wires then replace the light unit.



NOTE: OVER BAIL BED LINERS

Due to the uneven surface. over rail bed liners can cause the hardtop to leak.

Auto Styling Truckman highly recommends converting to or replacing with an under rail bed liner.




5. Measure from the front of the side rails, apply tape and make marks in the positions shown below.

Double Cab: 240mm, 650mm, 1200mm Extended Cab: 240mm, 970mm, 1530mm



Tip: Use masking tape & pencil. Continue the lines to the inside of the bed or liner to aid alignment later.



6. Drill a 3mm pilot hole 15mm from the inside edge of the rail. Drill again with a 9mm bit.



7. Remove all swarf and paint hole edges with zinc rich primer to prevent corrosion.



8. Thoroughly clean the vehicle's rear window and the hardtop's bulkhead window (if fitted).



9. Fill the front corners of the bed with silicone sealant. (Where the side rails meet the front rail).

HEAVY LIFTING

We recommend the use of 4 people to lift the hardtop.



10. Lift the hardtop on to the vehicle.



11. With the top now on the vehicle check that the seal under the rear door is just touching the tailgate.




12. Align the top centrally on the vehicle bed.

- **13.** With the door closed, measure and mark the same dimensions as before onto the top (using Step 8's lines as a guide).
- **14.** Drill 3mm pilot holes to line up with the original holes. Re-check hardtop alignment.
- **15.** Complete the holes with a 9mm drill bit.





16. Insert the fixings as shown in the diagram, omitting the Nylock nut. Tighten to 8Nm.



17. Now add the nylock nuts under the threaded plates and tighten, again to 8Nm.



TIP: Apply a fine spray of water to the top of the tailgate before positioning the protective tape.

This will allow a little 'adjustment' before the water dries and the adhesive fixes the tape into position.




18. Thoroughly clean the top of vehicle's tailgate with the wipe provided.



19. Unroll the protective tape and cut one end square.



20. Partly remove the backing from the tape.



21. Carefully apply it to the tailgate where the door touches, rubbing outwards to remove any bubbles as you go.



22. Using a squeege will make removing any bubbles easier.



23. Trim the tape square at the other end.

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IMPORTANT NOTES

Ensure the tailgate is closed when driving.

DO NOT place animals in the load
area without adequate ventilation.

DO NOT exceed load limit
when using roof rails.

DO NOT use a pressure washer near the seals.

MAINTENANCE

Use a light oil to lubricate the lock and hinges. Check the tightness of the fixing clamps / bolts. (8Nm Torque)

CLEANING

Use ordinary non-ammonia based car cleaning products and a soft or microfibre cloth.
