1. Gel Coat Top Remove the shrink wrap packaging, retrieving the kit contents before disposal.

1. Painted Top Remove the cardboard packaging and the kit contents carefully from the pallet.

NOTE: The vehicle's third brake light must be disconnected to avoid glare in the rear view mirror.



2. Unscrew the vehicle's third brake light and pull it away from the bodywork.

3. Un-clip the connector and disconnect the wires then replace the light unit.



NOTE:

OVER RAIL BED LINERS

Tools Required

14mm Spanner or socket PH2 Screwdriver Silicone Sealant

Scissors

Squeegee

Water spray &

Due to the uneven surface, over rail bed liners can cause the hardtop to leak.

Auto Styling Truckman highly recommends converting to or replacing with an under rail bed liner.



4. Thoroughly clean the vehicle's rear window and the hardtop's bulkhead window (if fitted).



5. Fill the front corners of the bed with silicone sealant. (Where the side rails meet the front rail).

6. Lift the hardtop on to the vehicle.

HEAVY LIFTING We recommend the use of 4 people to lift the hardtop.



8. Align the top centrally on the vehicle bed.



11. Tighten the clamps gradually to approx 6Nm.



13. Thoroughly clean the top of vehicle's tailgate with the wipe provided.





7. With the top now on the vehicle, adjust the position so the front lines up with the vehicle body (as above), and the seal under the rear door is just touching the tailgate.



9. Completely unscrew each of the clamps.

12. Re-check the position of the canopy and, if necessary, slacken the clamps and adjust before re-tightening to 6Nm.

14. Unroll the protective tape and cut one end square.



10. Assemble the clamps in position, on the side rails.

NOTE:

TAILGATE PROTECTION

A roll of clear protection tape is provided to prevent particles of road dirt, trapped between the door seal and vehicle's tailgate, from damaging the paint work.



15. Partly remove the backing from the tape.

FAILGATE PROTECTION

TIP: Apply a fine spray of water to the top of the tailgate before positioning the protective tape. This will allow a little 'adjustment' before the water dries and the adhesive fixes the tape into position.



16. Carefully apply it to the tailgate where the canopy door seal touches, rubbing outwards to remove any bubbles as you go.



17. Using a squeege will make removing any bubbles easier.



18. Trim the tape square at the other end.

Ensure the tailgate and side windows (if applicable) are closed when driving. **Do not** place animals in the load area without adequate ventilation.

Do not exceed load limit when using roof rails.

Do not use a pressure-washer near the seals.

MAINTENANCE

MONTHLY Check the tightness of the fixing clamp bolts (*approx 6Nm Torque*) **3 MONTHLY** Use a light oil to lubricate the lock and hinges.

CLEANING
